PRESENTATIONS OFFERED

Choices

- Target Audience: At risk kids/high gang areas; middleschool (6th-8th) through highschool
- Description: Choices is a program that goes into the results of choosing to be associated with a gang. The three paths are incarceration, injury, or death. Images and real world examples given in a powerpoint format. Customized to their area (geographically).
- Time length needed: 75-120 minutes.

Gang Identifiers: Knowing the Signs

- Target Audience: Parents, school staff/administration, community programs.
- Description: Designed to teach the target audience about current basic gang trends and identifiers (including hand signs, terminology, tattoos, & graffiti) to help them correctly identify any potential gang presence in their district, and any possible gang activity within the student body/community.
- Time length needed: 60- 90 minutes.

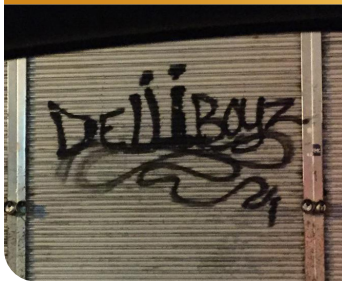
Gangs 101

- Target Audience: LEPS Programs/ criminal justice majors
- Description: Basic intro to gang program, designed for students in LEPS programs and criminal justice clubs (high school), criminal justice majors (college), or anyone pursuing a career in law enforcement. Explanation of how gangs and members are identified, with detailed information on specific gangs, sets, history, and current trends.
- Time length needed: 60-120 minutes

Gang Identifiers, Culture, and the Gang Influence

- Target Audience: School staff/administration, criminal justice majors, sociology majors, psychology majors, community programs.
- Description: An in-depth look into the gang culture and its impact on the community. Identifiers and current trends are also included.
- Time length needed: 60-120 minutes
